  - a. In person evening meetings for March and April

2. Student Council Report (Anicia Trejo-Flores/Sarah Smith)
  - a. School picnic on Friday was a success and we have a lot of ideas for ways to make next year better.
  - b. Planning for the last assembly of the year on 4/26 and prom on 4/27
3. Counseling Report (Kristine Mateos/Renee Ibarra)
  - a. AZSci testing was last week
  - b. ACT and ACT Aspire are happening over the next couple of weeks
  - c. Schedules for students are being input for next year
  - d. Staffing will remain the same for next school year despite ESSR funded positions previously being eliminated – we will be able to keep them due to other funding sources.
4. Principal's Report – (Kevin Amidan)
  - a. Current enrollment is 820 students
  - b. Budget for next year improved in that we only have to cut one full time position instead of the original estimate of 4 positions; district is reevaluating the funding formula
  - c. For 2025-2026SY Sabino will be a Title I school and the school will receive extra funding as a result.
  - d. Bond Money Update
    - i. With bond money coming through our first priority is school safety and security along with our HVAC system.

- ii. Gate by the library will be updated this summer and our new wrought iron fence around the front of the school will hopefully happen this summer as well.
  - iii. Stadium lights should be getting upgraded to LED lights with bond money but we have to wait until the district bond project committee to move us up on the list.
  - iv. Our stadium is on the bond initiative to get turf and Mr. Amidan is working to get the lights and turf to get done at the same time.
  - e. We did receive an orchestra pit cover so our fine arts can continue to host fine arts events. The head of Fine Arts for TUSD was able to push to get the pit cover paid for through a district fine arts expansion fund.
  - f. PBIS store is running well thanks to Monsoon Automotive's sponsorship
  - g. New bathroom pass policy where only one student can leave class for the bathroom at a time and they have to sign in and out.
  - h. Graduation will be on a Thursday this year. Security at graduation will change this year because the district has identified graduation as a vulnerable event for all schools. Guests will have to bring items in a clear bag. There will be added security to search bags to insure graduation is a safe event.
